**Sunday, April 25**

*Radford Fitness Center will be available for campers to utilize the shower facilities - hours are 8-4 each day. Hair dryers are provided!

*The fitness center is about two miles from the campsite - directions will be provided.*

**Directions to NAS:** (approximately 3 hours with potty stops)

I-10 west to Pensacola. Take exit 7. Turn left at the end of the exit ramp (traffic light) onto Pine Forest Road. Follow Pine Forest Road for about 2.5 miles.

Turn right at Blue Angel Parkway (traffic light). Continue on Blue Angel Parkway west for about 12 miles. Blue Angel Parkway dead ends at the back gate to Pensacola Naval Air Station. Stop at gate and identify yourself as a member of Pack 23 camping at the Jackson Court Scout Campsite. Show picture ID and obtain visitor pass.

Upon entering the base, Blue Angel Parkway becomes Radford Boulevard. Stay on Radford Blvd for approximately 3 miles (stay in the left lane).

Turn left on Taylor Road (just past the Naval Aviation Museum). Turn right on Hovey Road (second right).

Follow Hovey Road approximately 1/10 mile - the scout area is on the left. Turn left at corner and park where directed in front of the campsites.
